TENS machine and jaw tracker to obtain readings on muscle tension and optimal jaw position. The second appointment is less than an hour and focuses on ensuring the PPM is properly fitted. The PPM costs approximately \$2000 and is for athletic use only and not designed to treat specific neuromuscular dental disorders.
