

Neighborhood House offers free dental care

Dentists Kurt Doolin and Jeff Haddad of Rochester Advanced Dentistry announce they have partnered with the Rochester Area Neighborhood House (RANH) to offer a variety of dental services at no charge to RANH's youth clients on Tuesday, June 17 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Doolin said increasing needs for children in the community based on economic issues prompted the staff to investigate opportunities for giving back in a meaningful way.

"Our practice has been a part of the Rochester community since 1990 and we understand how the economy has affected families close to home," he said. "The Rochester Area Neighborhood House has a history of service to this area that dates back 40 years. Partnering with RANH was a logical connection for us given their long-term commitment here. They serve area families and have regular contact with those in need of dental services."

RANH Executive Director Peggy White is pleased to have a new partner for the organization.

"Rochester Area Neighborhood House has so many critical needs to fill now with Michigan facing such serious economic pressures," said White.

"Health services like dentistry are very impor-

tant to the overall well being of our clients, yet they are also difficult to provide at no charge. To

have Kurt Doolin and Jeff Haddad and their experienced staff offer these services and take such special interest in the RANH mission helps inspire us to keep moving forward."

Three of the office's dental hygienists will be working with Doolin and Haddad

on June 17 to offer children exams, cleanings, X-rays, fluoride, fillings and extractions. The practice is scheduling six patients per hour and anticipates seeing 30 patients.

They will extend the hours if necessary based on demand.

RANH will be working with their client base to schedule patients and all scheduling will be done through RANH.
